

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The John Howard Society of PEI, on behalf of the Rural & Remote Advisory Board (RAB) on Homelessness is seeking Proposals under the Government of Canada's Reaching Home Program.

The overall goal of Reaching Home is to "prevent and reduce homelessness by helping to establish the structures and supports needed to move homeless individuals and at-risk individuals towards self-sufficiency and full participation in Canadian society."

Funding is available through the National Housing Strategy (Reaching Home) to address the following priorities:

1. Prevention and shelter diversion
2. Client support services
3. Capital investments

The Proposal must include:

1. A brief description of your organization's mandate
2. How your organization proposes to address one or more of the identified priority areas; ie. objectives, activities, timelines and expected results
3. Location
4. Budget details
5. Any additional relevant information

The Call for Proposal funding is in effect for the fiscal period of April 1, 2020 - March 2021, with a possibility of extension. Organizations must submit their proposal no later than November 29, 2019 @ 4:00pm. The total amount of funding for this fiscal period is \$287,848.00. Funding applies to projects in Rural PEI and does not include the cities of Summerside and Charlottetown.
